

# *Eumops glaucinus ferox*

(Wagner's bonneted bat)

**Distribution:** This species ranges from Mexico to a large portion of Central America. It is only found in Cuba and Jamaica of the Antilles.. It is a fairly common species in Cuba, and widely distributed.

**Physical description:** This is a large bat weighing in at 30-45 g. The forearm length measures at 57-64 mm. Species from the genus *Eumops* present with a narrow muzzle and a smooth upper lip. The ears are wide and fuse at the forehead. The fur is short and brown.

**Roost:** They roost in manmade structures and tree hollows.

**Diet:** They are aerial insectivores.
